

**Frostburg Lions Club
Minutes – June 8, 2016**

The meeting was called to order by Lion Bill. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and "My Country, 'Tis of Thee" sung. Invocation was given by Lion Edge. Minutes of the previous meeting were distributed for reading by members. Minutes were approved as written. Treasurer Lion Cindy gave her report.

Lion Linda reported on correspondence. Club received ad check from Allegany Computer for \$100.00. Bills were received from the Wise Potato Chip Company and from FSU Printing Department. OLD BUSINESS

Saturday, July 30 has been set for our Food Drive benefiting the Frostburg Food Pantry. Vicki will set up a schedule for those who wish to volunteer that day. Time will be from 10:00 am until 3:00 pm in front of Save-A-Lot.

In the monthly District Newsletter, it was noted that Leader Dog has received in donations, pledges, and grants 14.5 million dollars, thus reaching their campaign goal. The new Canine Development Center is a state-of-the-art facility in Rochester, Michigan.

NEW BUSINESS

Lion Linda reported that she would like to hold a small "yard" sale at the church as a fund raising project. No Clothing – just nicknacks, household items, yard items, Christmas items, etc. Possible date could be Saturday, September 17.

Lion Linda saw an article in the newspaper concerning a project "Clean the World". That organization was collecting used soap from hotels, resorts, etc. and then sanitizing them, mashing them up, and then making new bars. These bars were then shipped to underdeveloped countries. They have produced 30 millions bars for 100 countries. Savage River Lodge was the #1 contributor sending 1,266 lbs. Bill asked her to get more details on the project.

Lion Liz reported that she is aving trouble getting vendors for a Health Fair this year. She will continue to work on this project and hopefully something can be set up in the Fall. She also advised that several organizations are helping with a dinner for the Camp Hope volunteers. It will be held on June 30. Seven (7) of our members volunteered to help. Liz will let those people know the details.

Lion Tom suggested that we name our Literacy Program after Dorothy Tosh and present her with a plaque when the money and books are donated to the Frostburg Library.
