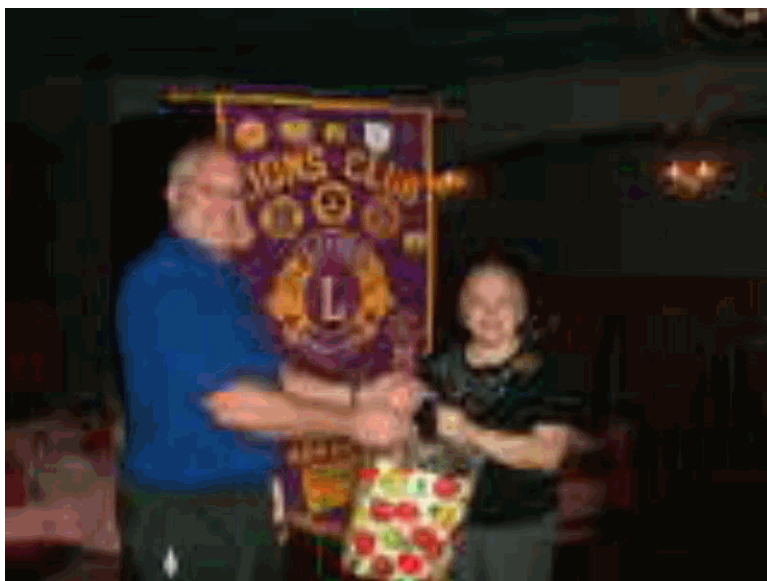
**Eyeglasses Recycling August 2014**
