Two Lions will be volunteering at the "Remote Area Medical" mission in Grundy, VA October 3-5. The mission will be held at the Riverview School, and includes medical, dental, and vision care. Lions will be volunteering with the vision group. We will be setting up donated frames on men's, women's, and children's tables in one of the classrooms, and assisting patients with choosing frames, after they have had their eyes examined. The frames they choose, their eye prescriptions, and their patient number, will be placed in stackable trays, and delivered to the mobile optical lab parked outside the school.

One Frostburg Lion will be working in the mobile optical lab, making glasses for each day's patients. The stackable trays are delivered to the front door of the lab, processed through an assembly-line of optical machinery from the front to the back of the lab, and then the finished glasses are stacked at the back door of the lab for pickup. "Runners" deliver & pick up the trays throughout the day. When the trays are picked up at the back door, the "runners" deliver them back to the classroom where I am working. They write the patient's number on a whiteboard outside the door, so that patients will know when their glasses are ready for pickup. Opticians then fit the patients with their new glasses.

We usually make between 200-300 glasses each day of the mission.
