

Frostburg Lions to host coat drive

FROSTBURG — The Frostburg Lions Club will conduct the seventh annual Coats for Kids coat drive Oct. 29 from 10 a.m. until noon in front of the Hotel Gunter, Main Street.

Since its inception, the coat

drive has collected nearly 5,000 coats both for children and adults. Coats are given to the Frostburg Interfaith Food Pantry, which distributes them for free.

Lion Susan Munck, coordinator of the coat drive, noted that coats should be clean and in good repair. The orga-

nization does not have the facilities to clean or repair donated coats.

Over the seven years of the coat drive, the Frostburg Lions Club has given coats to the Salvation Army, Hurricane Sandy Relief and the Frostburg Food Pantry for free distribution to the com-

munity. The coat collection goal for this year is 250 for children and adults.

Members of the community can drive up to the front door of the Hotel Gunter and drop off coats.
