

# Lions Club conducting 7th annual coat drive

Over the seven years of the coat drive, the Frostburg Lions Club has given coats to the Salvation Army,

Hurricane Sandy Relief and the Frostburg Food Pantry for free distribution back to the community. The coat collection goal for this year is 250 coats for children and adults.
