

Maryland, West Virginia to battle in Senior Classic Sunday

FROSTBURG — Many of the area's top seniors get one more opportunity to play high school basketball Sunday at Frostburg State University, which will host the 36th Frostburg Lions Senior All-Star Classic.

The games pit seniors from Western Maryland against their West Virginia counterparts. This

year's girls game tips off at 1:30 p.m., and the boys game will start at 3:30. Team rosters appear in today's Scoreboard page.

Last year, West Virginia won the girls game 55-27 and Western Maryland won the boys game 123-81.

Girls

The Maryland girls team features two of the more dominating players in recent history in Southern's Lauren Francillon and Allegany's Micah Wormack.

Francillon, a 6-foot-2 center who led the Rams to a 24-3 record, the Appala-

chian Mountain Athletic Conference title, a fourth straight region championship and trip to the Class 1A state tournament, averaged 19 points, 13 rebounds and four blocked shots. In her four seasons on the varsity team, the Rams won one state title, were state runners-up twice and a semifinalist once.

Wormack, a 6-0 center, led Allegany to an 18-6 season and a share of the City League championship and averaged 13.5 points, 16.6 rebounds, 4.1 blocked shots and 3.3 steals per game.
