

Basketball: Senior Classic Sunday at Frostburg

This year she set school records for points in a game (43) and most points (566) and rebounds (399) in a single season.

The West Virginia team features Frankfort's Madison Pfaff, Keyser's Sydney Lyons and Petersburg's Samantha Rohrbaugh, who were honorable mention Class AA All-State.

Pfaff, a 5-8 guard/forward, averaged 15.9 points, 7.7 rebounds and 4 assists in leading Frankfort to an 18-win season. Lyons averaged 9.3 points and 7.9 rebounds for the Golden Tornado, and Rohrbaugh 10 points, 4.6 assists and 3 steals for the Vikings.

Petersburg's Janie Pool will coach West Virginia and Northern's Jason Brenneman will coach Maryland.

The West Virginia boys

team features seven players who earned All-State honors, including Frankfort's Jacob Young, the area's scoring champion and second-team Class AA All-State.

Young, also first-team All-AMAC and first-team All-Potomac Valley Conference, averaged 21.5 points and 6.3 rebounds in leading Frankfort to an 18-7 season.

The team also includes first-team Class A All-State Seth Evans of Tucker County, who led the Mountain Lions to a 19-5 season and trip to the state tournament. Petersburg's Jace Shanholtz (18.6 points, 182 career three-point goals) and Ryan Van Meter (17.5 points, 5 assists) were Class AA honorable mention All-State, and Union's Nathan Evans (17.1 points, 11.2 rebounds, area leading 89.8 percent foul shooting), East Hardy's Tim Hahn and Tucker's Skyler Humphrey were Class A honorable mention All-State.

Maryland will counter with a strong team led by Allegany 6-4 forward Jason Copman, a third-team Class 1A All-State, AMAC Player of the Year and first-team All-City.

Among the players joining Copman will be Allegany teammate Darick Kerns, a 6-7 forward who was first-team All-City, Northern's Kyle Klotz, a 6-5 center who was first-team All-AMAC.

Copman and Kerns helped Allegany to a fourth straight area championship as well as AMAC and City titles and a 22-3 record. Copman averaged 17.6 points, 14 rebounds and 2.3 blocked shots. Kerns averaged 10.6 points, 7 rebounds, 3.4 blocked shots and 2.8 assists. Klotz averaged 16.4 points and 8.1 rebounds for the Huskies.

Petersburg's Todd Heare will coach the West Virginia team and Northern's Brian Schilpp will coach Maryland.
